

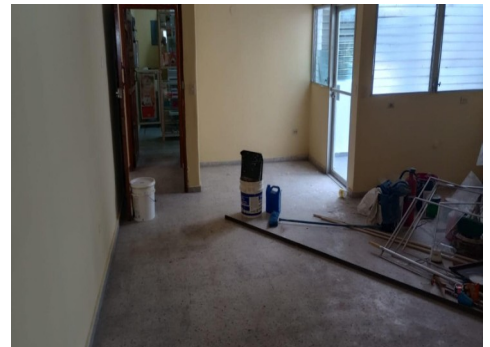

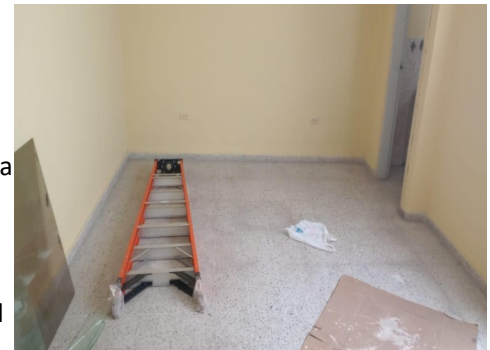

We had our eye on one nice building in a good location, but someone got it before us; however, the owner was very helpful and looked into some other building for us and sent me several choices. Among them, I was able to find one for us rather quickly.

The building isn't in a residential area per se. It's more of a downtown location and is very close to the soccer stadium. The area is very busy, so we are looking forward to meeting lots of new people. The space we are renting is on the 2nd story of the building and has one space for the main church and one that we'll use for the kid's area. It isn't a large area so, Lord blessing, we'll outgrow it quickly! I signed the contract today and we have a lot to do to prepare this building over the next few weeks, so pray that the process will go smoothly and we'll be up and running soon.



Our first priority is to start passing out invitations and information on the church, so pray that we could all of those materials printed out quickly. Some things have been prepared ahead of time but much of it had to wait until we knew what location we would be using, so now we are working hard to finish things up. Thankfully we know someone with a printing business. Beyond that, we have a list of shopping to do for items like chairs, cleaning supplies, a pulpit/stand for preaching, a small sound system, fans, curtains, etc. that we couldn't purchase earlier because we didn't have a place to store them. It's a long to-do list, but I am thrilled to finally be actively working on it.



Thank you for your prayers. We couldn't do this without you. We are looking forward to God's blessings this year, trusting that He will provide all that we need and bring many people to know Him in this new church plant.
